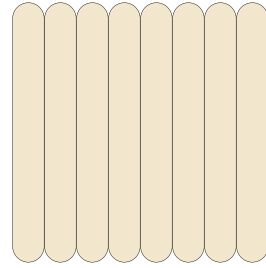
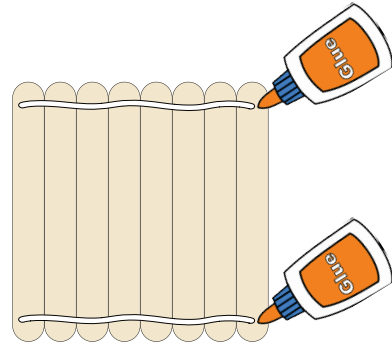


# Step 1: Make the base of your bird feeder

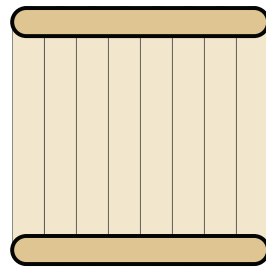
Lay 8 popsicle sticks side by side



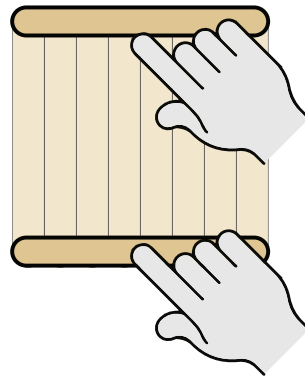
Make a line of glue at the top and bottom



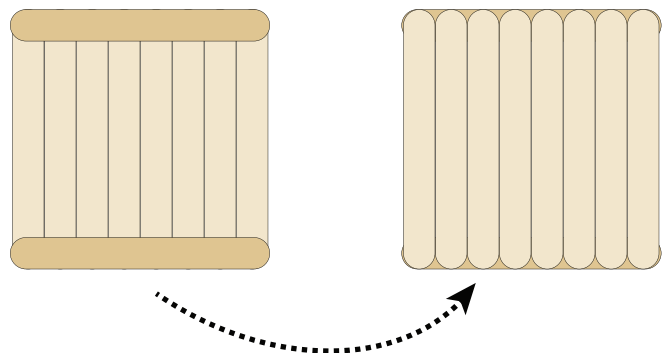
Put a new popsicle stick on top of each line of glue



Press and hold for 15 seconds

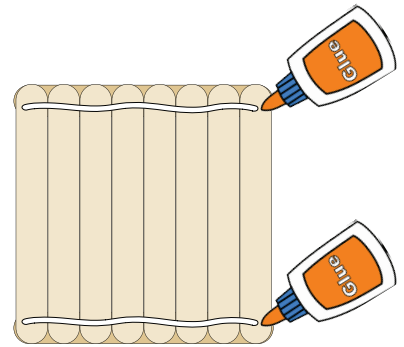


Flip your base over

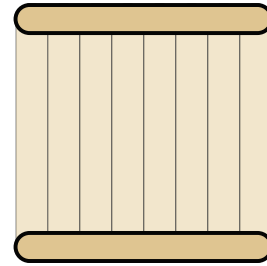


## Step 2: Add perches for birds to stand on

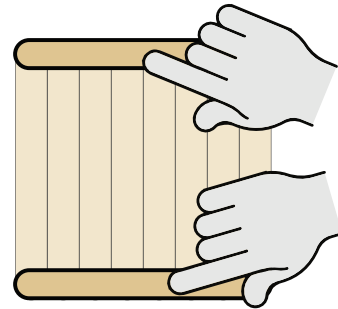
Make a line of glue at the top and bottom



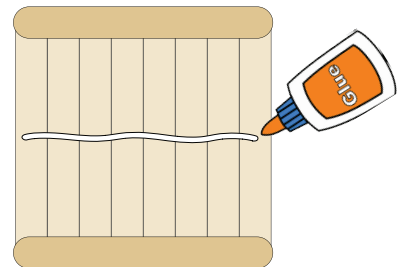
Put a new popsicle stick on top of each line of glue



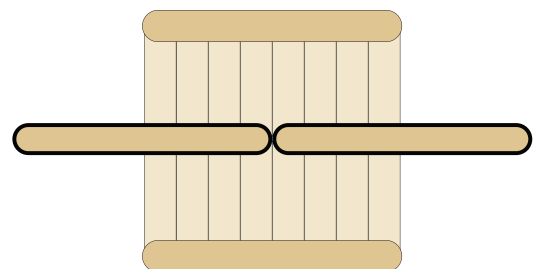
Press and hold for 15 seconds



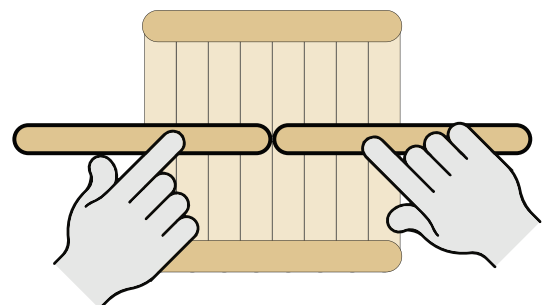
Put a line of glue across the middle



Put two new popsicle sticks so that the ends stick out from the sides of the base.

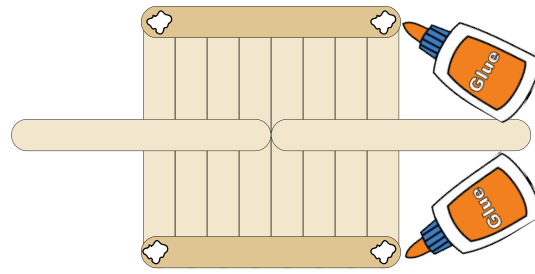


Press and hold for 15 seconds

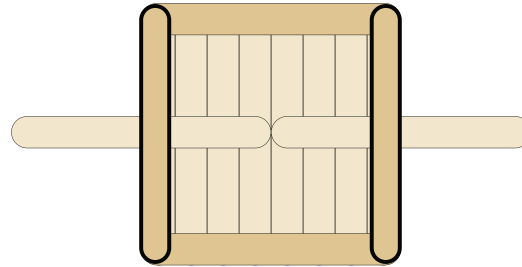


# Step 3: Build the sides of your feeder

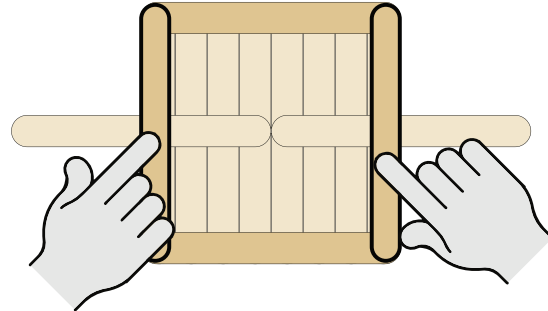
Put a dot of glue at each corner



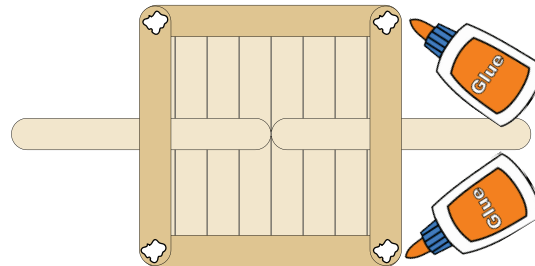
Add a new popsicle stick to both the left and right sides



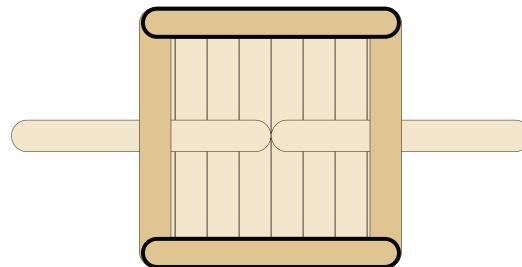
Press and hold for 15 seconds



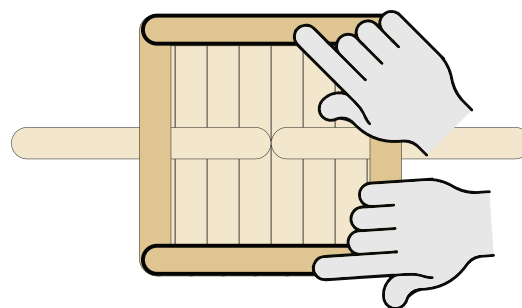
Put a dot of glue at each corner



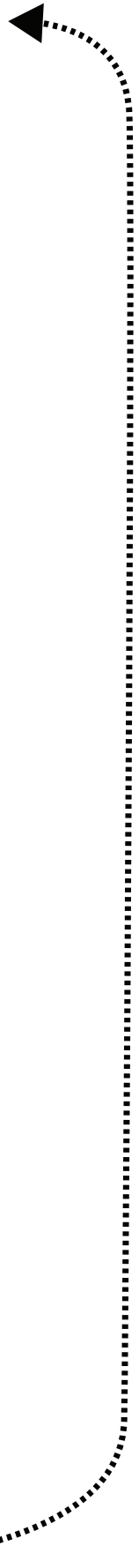
Add a new popsicle stick to both the top and bottom



Press and hold for 15 seconds

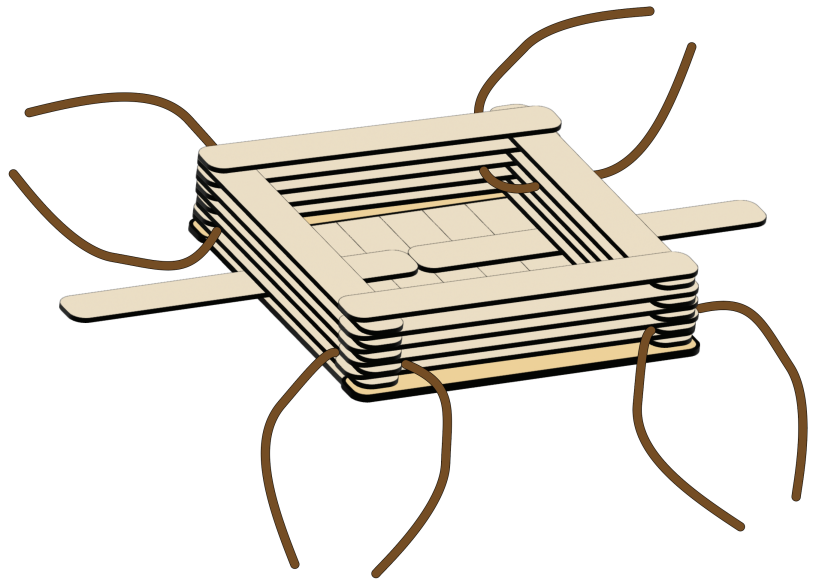


Repeat until all popsicle sticks are used.

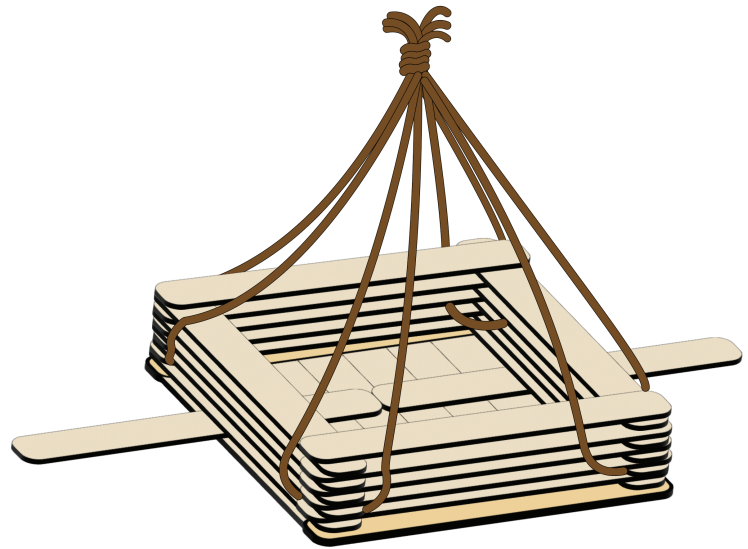


## Step 4: Attach string to hang your feeder

Slide a piece of string between popsicle sticks in each corner



Bring the ends of each string together and tie a knot



At home, hang your feeder and fill with bird seed!
